Do you maintain your own yard or hire someone to maintain it for you?

Yes, I do the yard myself. We did have someone do the stonework and add new soil to elevate the bed. Gumarco company did the stonework 214-960-9799...they have done several in the community.

What tips do you have for your neighbors who want to transform their yard?

I water just about every morning. Adding the evening watering if needed. Each zone I stop right before it begins to run off. These 100+ degree days have been critical.

What are your go-to flowers and plants that work well in the North Texas climate?

We have found Vinca's also known as Periwinkles, petunias (these are annuals) Salvia's are perennials that seem to thrive pretty well in this area. Been a lot of research and trial and error. Dorotheanthus Mezoos are great too, I use the Trailing Red version.

How do you maintain your lawn?

I use a pre-emergent followed by a weed and feed then every 2 months a lawn food... Turf Grow is a great brand. I also aerate the yard myself prior to application. I mow every 4 to 5 days during this time of year as the lawn grows fast.
